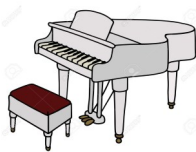

Won believes that music is a world language and expresses feelings, thoughts and the experience of daily events using tones rather than words.

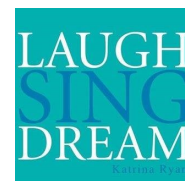
