From the Principal

Dear Families,

Teaching (and learning)

As the year draws nearer to a close, we begin our yearly assessment cycle, where the students complete a various number of assessments as to ascertain their growth across the course of the year.

At present we are measuring students' competencies in reading comprehension, Mathematics and Spelling. Later in the term they will complete some further assessments referred to as Dibels that further ascertain students decoding, fluency and comprehension ability.

Excitingly, we are beginning to see the fruits of the teaching and learning consistency we have delivered across the site this year, as the early signs is that across our site we have **above average learning growth**.

With a re-focus and training on PLD across the site, as well as the use of Maths Reviews (daily revision of key concepts previously learnt) we are seeing the signs of strong growth in our learning data. This has been an enormous amount of work by our teachers and leadership to create this consistency.

While we aim for one year of growth each year, we know that this is not a straight linear pathway, much in the same way our children don't grow in height identically each year. There are spurts and changes. Some years we may see 2 years growth in Reading, with spelling to follow the next year. Other years we may see a plateau as children consolidate concepts.

We went through a similar journey when I led the community at Yorketown. By the 4th year of my principalship there we demonstrated as a school the 5th strongest growth of all Catholic Schools in South Australia, and 18th overall across the course of the state across that four-year period. I believe we are on a similar trajectory here at Newton but further along.

What is most important is that we are creating consistency across the site, measuring the impact of that consistency, and ensuring that our children are receiving the best educational experience possible.

We'd like to introduce a new member of the St Francis family Miss Bianca Silvestri. Bianca will join us in 2025 teaching in the Middle Primary at our school.

A Mary Mackillop College old scholar, Bianca has been part of a high performing environment at Salisbury Primary School, a school that has hosted study tours each year to observe the teaching practice on site. We're super excited about what Bianca will bring to St Francis and can't wait to have her on board next year.

APRIM News

ReLAT

In Term 3 all Year 4 students in South Australia Catholic Schools participate in the Religious Literacy Assessment Tool. Religious Education (RE) is a core Learning Area in all Catholic schools. The assessment is not a measure of a child's faith nor their participation in the broader life of the Catholic community. It is an assessment of RE Curriculum that has been taught.

I am pleased with our school's results in ReLAT this year. Our average results was 25.2 out of 35 questions correct or 72% achievement. The average for SA is 22.6 out of 35 questions correct or 64.7% achievement. As you can see our school achieved 7.3% higher than the state average. The data from the ReLAT assessment will be collated and used by the school to inform whole-school professional learning needs and the continuous improvement of teaching in Religious Education. Individual results will be sent home to parents this term.

Whole School Events

Last Friday Fr Anthony led a beautiful whole school Mass for us. It was lovely to see many parishioners join us. Our next whole school Mass is not until Graduation and the Church renovations will be completed by then. There will be Community Prayer on Friday for the next 3 weeks led by 6V, 5R and then 3/4Z. The Year 6's will also lead us in a Remembrance Day liturgy on Monday 11th of November at 10am in the MPF. It is a busy term with many community events that bring joy and connection to our families.

The Mini Vinnies are preparing for our Vinnies Christmas Appeal. This year each class will be given a tub and a list of items needed to fill Christmas Hampers for Vinnies. Our St Francis community is always generous when supporting those in need. Each class has different items that they will be donating and you will receive further information next week about what items to donate.

TIP OF THE WEEK

Q. How do I cancel food orders that have already been paid for?

A. To cancel a food order from your itemized eReceipt:

1. Open Qkr! and tap Activity.
2. Scroll down to 'Order History' and sign in with your password.
3. Tap the red circle with a minus symbol on the order to be cancelled. Select the entire order or individual items to cancel and tap 'OK'.
4. If your eReceipt contains food orders for more than one child, you will need to cancel one by one.


OR

To cancel a food order from the calendar view:

1. Open Qkr! and select the relevant menu.
2. Tap on the tick icon on the date for which you want to cancel the order.
3. Tap the red circle with a minus symbol on the order to be cancelled. Select the entire order or individual items to cancel and tap 'OK'.

Cancelled items are shown in red on your eReceipt confirming they have been cancelled and a credit is available for future food orders. The value of any credits will be automatically deducted from your next Qkr! food order.

Please contact your school office to cancel any other (non-food) school payments according to school policy.
